5.5 Days of Significance - National Indigenous Veterans Day

Erica Mittag stated that National Indigenous Veterans Day was not included on the Days of Significance list approved by the Committee in 2024. Ms. Mittag advised that National Indigenous Veterans Day is November 8, 2025.

Discussion ensued regarding:

- supporting National Indigenous Veterans Day;
- including National Indigenous Veterans Day on the Days of Significance list;
- laying a wreath at one of the Town's cenotaphs on National Indigenous Veterans Day; and,
- contacting the Whitby Legion and Indigenous veterans to consult on the next steps for honouring, celebrating, and raising awareness of National Indigenous Veterans Day.

Councillor Yamada provided an update regarding:

- a resolution by Council regarding a Rental Unit Renovation By-law and Renovation Licence Program;
- a resolution by Council regarding Combatting Antisemitism and Hate Motivated Criminal Acts which includes directing the Chief Administrative Officer to report on the possibility of establishing a protocol or policy to notify various human rights organizations when hate motivated criminal acts are identified by Town staff and to consult with Durham Regional Police Services (DRPS); and,

- a resolution by Council supporting B'nai Brith's call to the Government of Canada to pass legislation banning the public display of Nazi symbols and iconography.

Erica Mittag stated that the Durham Children's Aid Society and Whitby Public Library were hosting Drag Queen Story Time on May 31, 2025. Ms. Mittag advised that the event would take place at the Heydenshore Pavilion and that the Whitby Public Library requested funding from the Committee to assist with the cost of renting the facility.
