4.1 Amanda Morrow, Senior IDEA Specialist, Town of Whitby

Re: The Town of Whitby's Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Anti-Racism (IDEA) Project Update

Amanda Morrow provided a presentation regarding the Town of Whitby's Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Anti-Racism (IDEA) Project update. Highlights of the presentation included:

- a list of Town of Whitby Advisory Committees that align with the goals of advancing equity;
- past, current, and upcoming initiatives that support the Community Strategic Plan and Culture Plan goals to enhance empathy, respect, representation and sense of belonging for employees and residents; and,
